Pastors: Please go over these rules with your campers before camp!

We love your kids and want the best for them. Here is how that will happen.

CAMP RULES

1. Only those campers ages 8-12 (by July 26th) years will be allowed to stay on campus.
2. Each dormitory will have a Head Counselor who will be responsible for the care and safety of all campers staying in their dormitory.
3. All counselors and camp staff will be respected by all campers.
4. There will be no profanity, back talking, stealing, or fighting.
5. Each camper will be expected to attend and be on time for all services and activities.
6. No campers are allowed off campus without Camp Director's permission.
7. Everyone staying in our dormitories will be old enough to know right from wrong. (We cannot put every little do or don't in our rules.)
8. All registered campers are required to wear their name band at all times.
19. Absolutely no pranks allowed. Camper will be held liable for ANY damage to property as a result of a prank will result in student being sent home without refund.
10. All luggage should be labeled with name and address.
11. No inappropriate or worldly logos or messages on clothing will be allowed.
12. No jewelry of any type will be allowed.
13. There will be no physical contact between boys and girls.
14. The boy's dorm area is off limits to all girls and the girl's dorm area is off limits to all boys.
15. No campers are to go to areas of the camp designated off limits.

Dress Rules

Modesty is our privilege!

Girls

1. All skirts / dresses are expected to be below the knees.
2. There will be no sleeveless tops allowed.
3. There will be no shorts, slacks, knee pants, pantsuits, or gauchos.

Boys

1. All pants are to be full length. (No knee pants, shorts, etc.)
2. There will be no sleeveless shirts, tank tops, or see through shirts.
3. Hair should be cut appropriately.

Note: All media and devices will be monitored closely and will not be viewed outside of the attention of a counselor/adult. Inappropriate use could result in camper/counselor/ or helper being sent home without refund.

Pastors and parents, please help us avoid having to tell anyone that they are not appropriately dressed.

Counselors/helpers

To be a counselor, you must be at least 18 years of age, approved by your pastor, and have no criminal (felony) record. You must apply using the attached forms including pastoral reference.

Helpers must be approved by the NC director.

Duties:

- Responsible for the care and safety of student attending camp.
- Maintain constant vigil to ensure order and discipline.
- Stay in dorms with campers and monitor behavior.

- Ensure campers attend and are on time to all services.
- Ensure campers do not leave campus.
- Report to the assigned Head Counselor or appropriate leadership.
- Carry out a head count each evening to ensure no camper is missing.
- Please come prepared to work hard, to worship, to pray with the children in the altar, and to have a great time.

Pastors, please encourage a 1 to 5 ratio (of workers to children) from your church (not mandatory).

Miscellaneous

Anyone staying on campus must furnish their own:

- linens
- cover
- towels
- washcloths
- soap
- any other toiletries or supplies.

There will be three meals per day: Breakfast, lunch, and dinner
Snacks will be provided in between
