

NC Jr Camp Rules

Pastors and/or Children's Directors: Please go over these rules with your campers before camp. Thank you for respecting guidelines for district events.

CAMP RULES:

- Only campers ages 8-12 (by July 11th) years old will be allowed to stay on campus.
- Each dorm will have a head counselor who will be responsible for the care and safety of all campers staying on campus.
- All counselors and camp staff will be respected by all campers.
- There will be no profanity, back talking, stealing, fighting, bullying, pranking.
- Each camper is expected to be on time and attend all services and activities.
- No campers are allowed off campus without the Camp Director's permission.
- All registered campers are required to wear their armbands at all times.
- Absolutely no pranks allowed. Campers will be held liable for ANY damages to property as a result of pranking and will be sent home without a refund. This includes pulling the fire alarm.
- All luggage should be labeled with name and address.
- No inappropriate or worldly messages on clothing allowed.
- No jewelry of any type will be allowed.
- There will be no physical contact between boys and girls.
- The boy's dorm is off limits to girls and the girl's dorm is off limits to boys.
- No campers are allowed in areas of the camp designated off limits.
- All cell phones and media devices will be monitored closely and will not be used outside the attention of a counselor or adult. Pictures inside dorm rooms of inappropriately dressed campers will not be allowed. Phones will be confiscated until camp is over if not used appropriately.

DRESS RULES:

Modesty is our privilege. Pastors and parents, please help us avoid having to tell any camper they are not dressed appropriately. If you have new campers to your church, please help them understand the district rules.

Girls:

- All skirts and dresses are to be below the knee.
- There will be no sleeveless tops allowed.
- There will be no shorts, slacks, knee pants, pantsuits, or gauchos allowed.

Boys:

- All pants are to be full length. No knee pants or shorts allowed.
- There will be no sleeveless shirts, tank tops, or see through shirts allowed.
- Hair should be cut appropriately.
